RULES AND GUIDELINES

Registrations will be received on a first come basis. You will be assigned your site space upon arrival for set-up the day of the event. Electric fee (if required) is non-refundable. No refunds due to inclement weather.

Scare Site Spacing

Scare Sites will be approximately 20 X 20 for each group. If you need more space, please register for two spaces on your registration form. Registration is for space only-supplies for site are not provided. No bolts, screws, hooks or nails shall be driven into buildings, trees, or pavement.

Electricity

Access to existing electricity in the park will be provided for a fee in areas where there is electricity. There are areas in the back of the park that do not have access to electricity and will require a generator. If assigned to this area, it is the organization's responsibility to provide a generator or the Committee will supply a generator for a fee if requested. Please include the fee with your application. You will be responsible for gas for the generator and its care.

Set-up and Care

Scare Site set-up may begin on Thursday, Oct. 19 and/or Friday Oct. 20 during the day. Sites and displays must be set up and ready to go by 6 pm on Friday Oct. 20 and will be left up in the park during the day time. Vehicles are permitted near your site during set-up on Thursday and Friday. Please move vehicles to designated parking areas prior to 6 pm on Friday, Oct. 20 and 6 pm on Saturday Oct. 21. **All sites must be torn down and removed from the park by 5pm, Sunday Oct.**

22 . Items left in the Park after Sunday maybe removed and disposed of by Greenville Parks Department Employees.

Scare Site Restrictions

All spectators will be driving through the park in their personal vehicles. Live actors in costumes are STRONGLY ENCOURAGED! Scarers may approach vehicles, shine lights, make noise, etc. but **PLEASE DO NOT TOUCH** vehicles or person's in the vehicles. Special effects such as colored lights, fog, and noise/music are allowed. Strobe lights are permitted please let us know ahead of time so that we can have warning signage upon entrance to the park for those with sensitivities.

Any chainsaws being used MUST have chains removed.

The Greenville Heritage Days Committee shall have full power to interpret or amend these rules. In the event that these stated policies do not appear to cover a specific situation(s), the Greenville Heritage Days Committee reserves the right to make such ruling as may be in the best interest of the event, and the participant agrees to abide by such rulings.
